

Washington Title IX Complaint School Board Member Declaration

I hereby declare as follows:

1. I, _____, am a citizen of the State of Washington.
2. I am member of the _____ School Board which is responsible for managing the _____ Public School District.
3. The _____ Public School District is a non-profit organization responsible for the education of _____ students here in Washington State.
4. As a school board member, I have sworn an oath of office to support and uphold the Washington State Constitution and the United States Constitution.
5. I have become aware of the January 9, 2025 ruling of the federal court in Tennessee v Cardona concluding that several provisions of the 2024 Title IX Final Rule violate Title IX. I am also aware that this federal court ruling applies to Washington state. I want to comply with this court order. I will not violate the Title IX rights of our students.
6. Despite the Tennessee v Cardona ruling, Washington superintendent Chris Reykdal continues to require every school board in Washington state to enforce Policy 3211 and 3211 P – which includes many provisions that are identical to the policies courts have now ruled are in violation of Title IX. This puts me and every other member of our school board in an impossible position because, as a school board member, I am forced to comply with Policies 3211 and 3211 P , which will in turn, require me to break my oath of office and betray the trust placed in me by our teachers, parents, students and voters.
7. State Superintendent Reykdal has threatened to withhold state funding if our school board fails to comply with State Policies 3211 and 3211 P. However, because our school district receives federal funding, we are required by federal law to comply with Title IX.
8. The failure to Superintendent Reykdal to comply with Title IX therefore inflicts irreparable harm on me as a school board member as well as on our teachers, administrators, parents and students. I therefore ask the US Department of Education Office of Civil Rights to find Chris Reykdal in violation of Title IX and further to find Washington state policies 3211 and 3211 P to be in violation of Title IX. This will allow our school district to continue to receive both state and federal funding and be in compliance with both Washington state and federal laws.
